This free calculator does one thing well: it nets one week down to what's actually yours. Enter your service income and tips, your booth rent and product cost, and a tax set-aside — it returns your money in, your costs, your take-home before tax, and your real take-home.

A BUSY WEEK ISN'T A PAID WEEK

The rent is due whether the chair was full or empty, the product comes out of your pocket, and nobody withholds your taxes. Take-home is what's left after all of that — the number to watch, not the gross that rang through the drawer.

How to use the calculator

- 1 Open Booth-Renter-Take-Home-Calculator.xlsx (Excel, Google Sheets, or LibreOffice), or use the web version on the page you downloaded it from.
- 2 Enter one week's service income and tips.
- 3 Enter your booth rent and your product & supplies for the same week.
- 4 Set your tax set-aside percentage, and read off your real take-home.
