

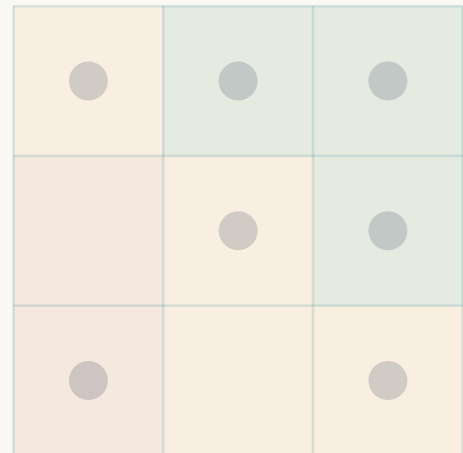

Your free 9-box starter grid

A 9-box talent grid is the simplest way to see your team's talent and succession risk on one page. Plot each person on two axes — how they perform in their role now, and how much potential they have to take on more — and they land in one of nine boxes, from Talent Risk in the bottom-left to Star in the top-right.

How to use the starter board

- 1 Open 9-Box-Starter-Grid.xlsx in Excel, Google Sheets, or LibreOffice.
- 2 For each person, decide their box from their performance and potential, and type their name into it.
- 3 Read the shape: an empty top row is a succession gap; a lone name in a box on a critical role is a key-person risk.

READY FOR THE WHOLE PICTURE?

This starter places people by hand. The full 9-Box Talent Grid does it for you: score two axes and each person is auto-placed in the right box, with a live calibration grid, box-by-box counts and named lists, a suggested focus for every box, a scoring guide, and a review log — one owned 7-tab file for Excel, Google Sheets, and LibreOffice, plus four guides.
