



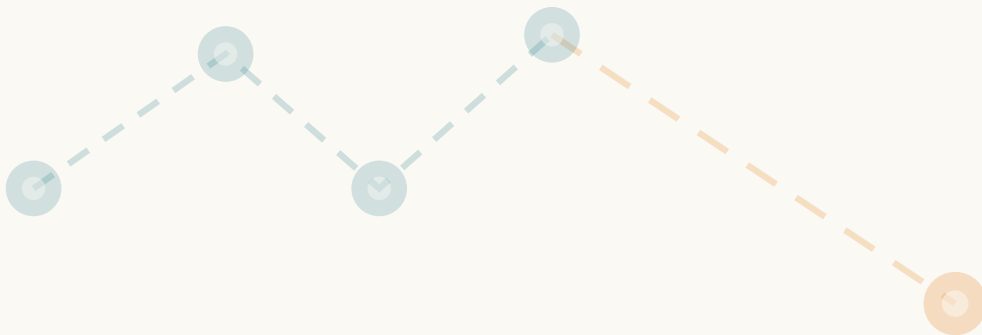

Recurring Job Schedule Planner

A free tool — your recurring clients in, your week and your year out.

What this free planner does

A recurring cleaning or home-service book is easy to run out of a phone and impossible to see. This one-tab planner turns it into two numbers you can act on: what your regular clients are worth over a year, and who is due next.

How to use it

- 1 Open **Recurring-Job-Schedule-Planner.xlsx** in Excel, Google Sheets, or LibreOffice. It arrives pre-filled with a worked example — clear those rows once you have seen how it behaves.
- 2 Enter each recurring client: the name, the zone or side of town, the day you serve them, the frequency (a dropdown), and the price of one visit.
- 3 Type the date you **last** served them. Visits a year, annual revenue, and the **next due** date compute themselves.
- 4 Sort by **Next due**, ascending, and the top of the list is next week's route.

What it deliberately does not do

It does not tell you whether any of that work is profitable. Annual revenue is not annual profit, and the gap between them is mostly made of two things this free tool cannot see: what an hour of your own time costs, and how much of your day you spend driving between the stops.

The Cleaning & Service-Business Job & Route Manager works out your true cost per hour, then charges every visit its real clock hours — drive time included — plus crew and supplies. Profit, margin, dollars per hour of your day and a colored status on every client; route density by service day and by zone; a quote builder; supplies costed per use; a job log; and a dashboard that tells you whether the book fills the year your rate assumes.
