



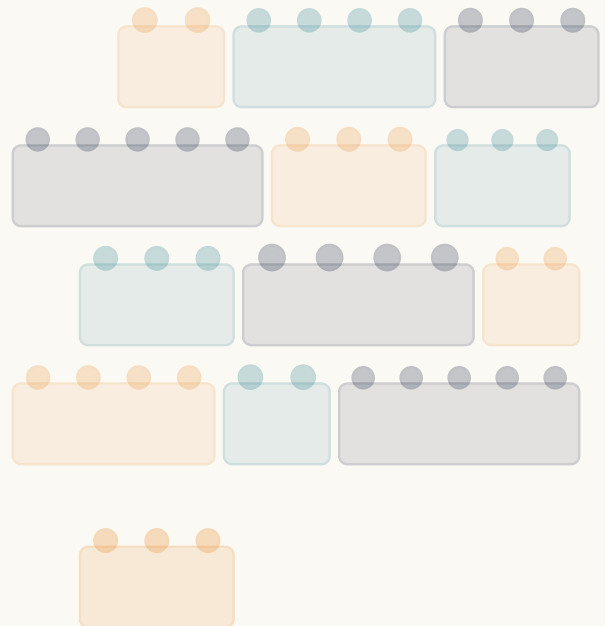

TRACKERS FOR THE THINGS YOU LOVE

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Your free set-shelf starter

Here's the quiet thing about a growing shelf: it out-runs your memory. You stand in a store genuinely unsure whether you already own the small one, and the box you bought on release day is still shrink-wrapped two years later. The fix is small — a row per set. This free starter is a single tab: log the set number and name, note the theme and the piece count, and mark it built or still sealed.

How to use it

- 1 Open Set-Collection-Tracker-Starter.xlsx in Excel, Google Sheets, or LibreOffice.
- 2 Add a row per set; pick the theme from the dropdown and mark it Built or Sealed.
- 3 The summary up top keeps a running count of your sets, your pieces, and — the one most of us would rather not know — how many are still in the box.
- 4 It opens pre-loaded with a small fictional collection so you can see it working. Clear those rows and make it yours.

READY FOR THE WHOLE SHELF?

This starter counts your sets and flags what's sealed. The full Set Collection & Build Tracker works out what every set cost you per piece and how that compares to what you reckon it's worth now; adds a live Dashboard that tells you what the unbuilt pile cost; a Wishlist with a retirement read on every set you're hunting; a Build Log that works out your pieces-per-hour; a missing-parts log that flags the set until you fix it; a Minifigures tab; three PDF guides; and a one-click Google Sheets copy — one owned file for Excel, Google Sheets, and LibreOffice.
