



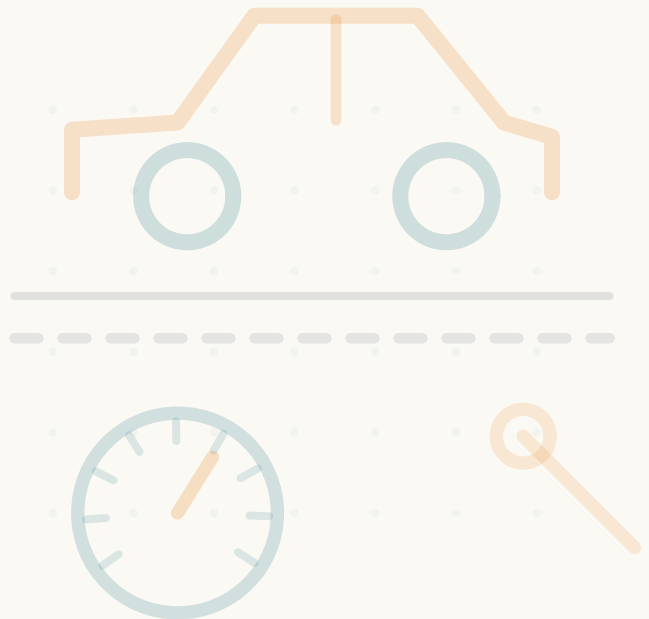

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Every vehicle you own, on one page

Walk out to each vehicle with this page and a phone. The VIN — the Vehicle Identification Number, 17 characters — is on the plate at the base of the windshield and in the driver's door jamb; the registration card in the glovebox has the expiration date, and the insurance card has the rest. Twenty minutes, once, and the answers are in one place for the traffic stop, the claim, or the sale. Record who insures it and where the documents live — never policy numbers, account numbers, or logins.

This is one page of a whole system. The full Vehicle & Auto Records Binder doesn't just hold these facts — it works out what's actually due. Type each vehicle's odometer and when a service was last done, and it flags every item by date and by mileage, whichever comes first; it counts every registration, insurance and inspection renewal down in days; and it adds a service history with a running total, a recall and warranty tracker, loan and lease math, and a document and key index — a 10-tab workbook (Excel & Google Sheets) plus three guides.
